COVID RECOVERY—Starts Now!

ABILITY really want to help people start getting back out into the community, numbers have understandably reduced during the Covid period although we have continued to offer the essential shopper service through the last 9 months and given other help to local communities during these difficult times including delivery of food parcels.

We are a 'ring and ride' service that anyone can use. There is no fixed timetable - the bus follows a route on a demand basis and is set by the pre-booked requests of passengers. For our journeys we group people together and create a route that is most economical/sensible.

Everyone must register and prebook a seat, this is greener for the environment and means we know how many people will come on-board (needed for Covid restrictions). Pick up times are always approximate, we suggest allowing 10 minutes either side.

We are much more than a bus service, we are a social club on wheels!

You will find enclosed the villages and days we are taking residents to their local towns.
