




Creation of a Temporary Road and Associated Infrastructure on Land North of B4525 Welsh Road, Greatworth

April 2021



Proposal

Creation of a temporary road between Sulgrave Road and B4525 Welsh Road, including creation of a 3-arm roundabout connecting to the western arm of B4525 Welsh Road and a second 3-arm roundabout connecting to southern arm of Sulgrave Road, and the creation of a temporary road connecting B4525 Welsh Road with Greatworth Park together with associated landscaping and infrastructure



Scheme Benefits Over Act Scheme

- The purpose of this new proposed alignment is to rationalise the construction process and minimise disruption to the local highway network. The proposed development will:-
 - Remove the need for a temporary road at Banbury Lane for the tunnelling works;
 - Provide a safer route off B4525 Welsh Road for deliveries to Greatworth Green Tunnel Compound;
 - Provide more continuity of flow of traffic to avoid possible queues at normal T-junctions, at the Sulgrave Road/Welsh Road junction;.
 - Allow the reinstatement of the road into its new alignment without multiple diversion phases.
- The single approach to phasing of the road would minimise the duration of road closures to the benefit of both the project and road users;
- The new alignment will minimise disruption to the public, minimise diversions, and provide a safer environment for both the public and construction traffic.



Banbury Road Closure

Magpie Junction to Bulls Lane



Banbury Road Diversion Route:
Greatworth Road, Sulgrave Road,
Welsh Lane (B4525), Banbury Lane

- The section of Banbury Lane between Magpie Junction will be closed to carry out the construction activity in this area comprising of the tunnel portal activity and road reinstatement.
- Durations and timescales to be confirmed.
- Diversion route as indicated though will be via the Greatworth Tee once in place..
